

DIRECTIONS FROM ASHEVILLE, NC TO CAMP NATHANAEL

DISTANCE FROM ASHEVILLE – APPROX. 180 MILES
DRIVING TIME TO CAMP – APPROX. 4 HOURS

At Asheville, exit off I-26 onto US 23 north toward Tennessee.

You will stay on US 23 north through Kingsport, Duffield, Big Stone Gap, Norton to Jenkins, KY. Most of this is four-lane highway.

Before you enter Jenkins, you will be coming down a long hill (Great view!!). Part way down the mountain you turn left onto US 119 south toward Whitesburg and Hazard, KY.

At Whitesburg, near a McDonald's & Pine Mt. Grill, take KY 15 toward Hazard, KY. (Straight ahead) You leave US 119 at this intersection.

As you travel beside Carr Creek Lake (on your left) you will want to be looking for KY 160. There will be a caution light at the intersection. Turn right toward Hindman, KY on KY 160.

As you enter "downtown" Hindman you will turn left onto KY 550 west (Traffic light at intersection). Follow KY 550 to Emmalena.

About 8 miles from Hindman you should see the Camp Nathanael sign on your left by a bridge (About ½ mile past KY 1102). Turn left across the bridge (if pulling a trailer you will need to make a wide turn onto bridge) and follow the paved road into the camp property.

If you miss the first entrance stay on KY 550 and at Emmalena, you will pass the school (left) and post office (right) then Camp Nathanael's second entrance is around the next curve.

There are two stone signs which say "Camp Nathanael". Follow the paved road (it's marked Camp Nathanael Road) until you pass the gym on left, cross a bridge and you'll see the stone chapel across the field.
