

DIRECTIONS FROM LEXINGTON, KY TO CAMP NATHANAEL

DISTANCE FROM LEXINGTON – 125 MILES
DRIVING TIME FROM LEXINGTON – 2 ½ HOURS

From Lexington, take I-64 east to Winchester

Just past Winchester, exit off of I-64 onto the Bert Combs Mountain Parkway toward Campton and Pikeville.

Follow the Parkway to Campton and exit onto KY 15 toward Jackson and Hazard. (Large green sign clearly states Jackson and Hazard. Do not take the first exit marked KY 15. Look for the large exit sign.)

At Hazard, turn left (traffic light) onto KY 80 east toward Hindman and Prestonsburg.

Follow KY 80 (four lane highway) approximately 7 miles to KY 476.

As you descend a hill you will see "Absolute Storage" on your right. At the bottom of the hill (not well marked) you turn left, cross a concrete bridge, and then turn right at the stop sign. Now you are on KY 476 east. [FOLLOW CAMP NATHANAEL SIGNS]

Follow KY 476 approximately 1 ½ miles to Dwarf. At Dwarf, you will turn left onto KY 550 east. There is a large building on the left at the intersection. This is a poor intersection so be careful.

Follow KY 550 about 5 miles to Emmalena. There are two stone signs which say "Camp Nathanael". Follow the paved road (it's marked Camp Nathanael Road) until you pass the gym on left, cross a bridge and you'll see the stone chapel across the field.

If you miss the first entrance stay on KY 550 and at Emmalena, you will pass the school (right) and post office (left) then Camp Nathanael's second entrance is around the next curve.

You will see the camp sign on your right. Turn right across the bridge (if pulling a trailer you will need to make a wide turn onto bridge) and follow the paved road into the camp property.
